Chastity Education

The Archdiocese of St Louis mandates that all Parish Schools of Religion and all full-time schools present chastity education for children in grades 4-8.

In the Parish Schools of Religion, the approved text is **God's Own Making**. There are three main topics covered each year at age appropriate times: Respect for Life in All Its Stages; Respect for Differences; Our Human Sexuality is Life-Giving and Love Giving. At no time is physiology a part of the discussion. The reason for covering chastity in the Parish School of Religion is to emphasize the theme of love as self-gift. The body shows us the call and gives us the means to love in the image of God. Chastity education encourages a true reverence for the gift of sexuality and challenges the student to live it in a way worthy of the great dignity of the human person.

Safe Touch

The Archdiocese of St Louis instituted a program for all students in full-time Catholic schools and parish schools of religion in 2005 called "Safe Touch". Only those trained by the Safe Environment Office may teach the program to help give children the tools they need to recognize that they are in control of their bodies and that no one has the right to disrespect them. Program goals are: to provide information at age-appropriate levels to make children aware of the concepts of safe touch vs. inappropriate touch; to stress that our bodies belong to God and that we must treat them with respect and protect them from harm to the extent we are able; to provide information in regard to: Good boundaries in real life and on the internet, Good touch/bad touch and recognizing the uncomfortable feelings we have with the latter, How to say NO and get away in bad situations, How to report concerns to a safe adult and to focus on safety rather than sexuality. Children are taught that they have the right to tell anyone, including adults, that they are uncomfortable with attention they are receiving, particularly if it involves touch.

Materials used are on file in the Religious Education Office and parents are welcome to inspect them. A curriculum for parents to teach the materials at home is available upon request. If a parent does not want their child(ren) to be included, written notice must be given to the Director.

Parent Witness Statement

Through the ages, the Church has consistently called on its parents to understand and appreciate their special dignity as instruments of God's love to their children. In recent years, the Church in its official teaching has given even greater prominence to the importance of this truth.

The Second Vatican Council, in its "*Decree on the Apostolate of the Laity*", stressed the importance of parents providing the first experience of faith to their children: ***They (Christian husbands and wives) are the first to communicate their faith to their Children and to educate them; by word and example they train their offspring for the Christian and Apostolic life.*** (Par. #11)

The Council Fathers even more emphatically expressed the irreplaceable role of the Parents in communicating faith to their children in its "*Declaration on Christian Education*". ***Since parents have conferred life on their children, they have a most solemn obligation to educate their offspring. Hence, parents must be acknowledged as the first and foremost educators of their children. Their role as educators is so decisive that scarcely anything can compensate for their failure in it.*** (Par. #3)

Therefore it is with complete awareness of the Catholic Church's vision of my vocation as a Catholic parent that I enroll my child in the Parish School of Religion. In doing so, I acknowledge and accept the privilege and responsibility to be the primary educator of my children. I understand that the Parish School of Religion is a way in which my Church seeks to share and assist me in my vocation. However, I know that no matter how clearly or effectively the Parish School of Religion communicates the truths of our faith, unless my children see these truths take flesh in our family, there is little hope that faith will take root in their hearts. I believe that the Parish School of Religion can deepen, enrich, and reinforce a faith that my children experience in their home. I understand my own witness as essential to the religious development and growth of my children.

Aware of the dignity of my call from God and with a reverent awe for the responsibility which is mine, I commit myself to be in word and deed the first teacher of my children. Practically, I understand this to mean:

- I will participate consistently in the Sunday Eucharist.
- I will speak to my children about the things of God, and to make prayer an integral part of the environment of our home.
- I will participate and cooperate, as the Parish School of Religion requests, in the religious education and especially in the sacramental preparation of my children.
- I accept responsibility to support the moral teachings of the Catholic Faith in order not to contradict in my home what is proclaimed in the PSR.
- I will teach my children by works and example to have a love and concern for the needs of others, especially the poor.
- I will do my share in financially supporting St Robert Bellarmine Parish and the Parish School of Religion.
